To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct the 10th ASEAN Online Quiz Regional Level Competition on February 17, 2022 at 8:30 A.M. to 12:00 noon via Zoom.
2. The activity aims to foster the spirit of healthy competition among ASEAN Youth in a friendly quiz game that exposes them to ASEAN cultural, political, economic and social information.
3. Participants to this activity are the 19 Division AP Education Program Supervisors, 19 Teacher-Coaches in ASEAN and 19 student-contestants who are division winners.
4. All coaches and student-contestants shall register online on or before February 14, 2022 using the link: <https://www.google.com/asean/region7>. There shall be a dry run on February 15, 2022 at 10:00 A.M. The link for the online quiz shall be given to the Division AP Supervisors a day before the actual date of the event.
5. Travelling expenses, load allowance and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants are chargeable against the School/Division MOOE/local funds. Meals and snacks for the Region TWG and onsite personnel which shall be served by the DepEd Applied Nutrition Center on February 15 and 17, 2022 shall be charged against ASEAN Fund. All are subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations

Mechanics and Guidelines (Preparations)

1. The coach and learner-participant must register using the link: <https://tinyurl.com/10th-ASEAN-Registration> not later than February 14, 2022.
2. The Regional ASEAN Quiz shall be conducted virtually using the zoom meeting application.
3. Each student-participant shall prepare two (2) gadgets with functioning cameras. One shall be placed in front of the participant and the other one shall be at the back of the participant that could give the full view of the room. All two gadgets of the participant shall log in to the zoom link to be sent to the Division Program Supervisors. All its cameras shall be turned on during the whole duration of the online quiz.
4. Each participant shall rename their two (2) gadgets using the following format:
Camera 1 (in-front of the learner) : Division_Camera1
Camera 2 (back of the learner) : Division_Camera2
5. The participant must face the blank wall in answering and the front gadget's microphone shall be turned on for the entire duration of the events. The other gadget's microphone shall be muted.
6. Each coach must prepare a white board, a marker and an eraser for their contestant. Before the start of the quiz, each participant shall show to the screen their white board for the checking. The participant's division name shall be written on the upper portion of their white board.
7. The coach must ensure that the place where the participant is located shall be free from all forms of background sounds and noises. This is to ensure that no one is coaching the participant while answering the items.
8. Only one (1) person shall be allowed inside the room (IT expert and not the coach nor the EPS) where the participant is located. He/she shall take charge ONLY on the technical issues and concerns.
9. The Schools Division Offices must ensure that there is a stable internet connection during the conduct of the event, aside from the WIFI connections, mobile data shall be prepared as back up in the event in order to address the internet connectivity problems.
10. In the event that the participant unintentionally left the meeting due to poor internet connection and other technical problems, he or she may resume with the quiz however questions that have been already asked shall not be repeated.
11. Only the correct answers that are acknowledged by the Quiz Master shall be given points.

12. It is expected that SDOs must check all the gadgets and internet connections prior to the conduct of the event.
13. There shall be simulation which will be done on February 15, 2022 @ 10:00AM while the Regional ASEAN Online Quiz shall be conducted on February 17, 2022 @ 8:30AM.

Quiz Mechanics for the Competition Proper

1. The 19 student-participants from DepEd's 19 divisions shall compete individually in two segments.
2. The two (2) segments are as follows:
Segment 1: True or False and Multiple Choice
Segment 2: Fill-in-the-Blanks or Completion
3. Segment 1: The True or False part will have 10 questions. Each correct answer will be given 1 point. The Multiple choice part will have 10 questions. Each correct answer will be given 1 point. Total is 20 points.
4. Segment 2: The Fill in the Blanks or Completion will have 20 questions. Each correct answer will be given 3 points. Total is 60 points.
5. The total points for the Competition is 80.
6. The participants shall be seated in individual chairs with armrest.
7. Each participant shall be provided a whiteboard, a marker and an eraser to be used in answering the questions for Segments 1 and 2. Participants will write their answers on the whiteboard.
8. For Segment 1 (True or False and Multiple Choice), participants will write the word True or False for the TRUE or FALSE questions and write the letter of the correct answer for the Multiple Choice questions. Participants will be given 10 seconds to write down their answer.
9. For Segment 2 (Fill in the Blanks or Completion), participants will be given 15 seconds to write down their answers. A buzzer shall indicate that the time is up. Answers should be written in full; with no abbreviations or acronyms. Articles and prepositions should be correct. Answers with wrong spelling will be considered wrong. Corrections may be made by the participants but the previous answers must be fully erased or fully crossed out within the given time allotment.

Each questions in Segments 1 and 2 will be read twice. After the Quizmaster reads the question the second time, he/she will say 'GO'. Only then will the participants write their answer. When the time is up, the Quizmaster will say "Markers Up". Participants will then hold up their markers and whiteboards to show their answers. The Quizmaster will read aloud the answers of each participant. The scorers will

record the answers accordingly. A cumulative score per participant will be announced by the quizmaster after each round before moving on to the next segment.

10. The Organizing Committee and Sub-Committee on Test Development and Quiz Mechanics shall provide technical support and clarification deemed necessary by the Board of Judges.
11. Scoring Systems. There will be two scoring systems to ensure correctness of tabulations. To be handled by a PTV Scoring Team designated by the Organizing Committee. These two scoring systems are: (1) by computer, and (2) manually, using scoring sheets and a tabulation board prominently displayed for the reference of the 19 student-participants, the Board of Judges, the 10th ASEAN Quiz National Competition Organizing Committee, the Sub-Committee on Test Development and Quiz mechanics, coaches and other guest.
12. After the competition of segment 2, the cumulative points earned by each participant in the two segments will be tabulated. The results will be examined and verified by the Tenth ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee. When the results have been verified, these will be submitted to the Board of Judges and announced accordingly by the Quizmaster.
13. The chairman of the Board of Judges shall declare the First, Second and Third Place Winners. The three highest pointers shall represent the Philippines in the 10th ASEAN Quiz Regional Competition in the third quarter of 2022 in Myanmar. The Fourth place winner shall be declared as the alternate team member in case one of the three winners will be unable to go to Myanmar for the Regional Competition.
14. In case of a tie, tiebreaker question/s shall be asked until definite winner/s emerge. At the start of the tiebreaker round, the scores revert to zero.
15. Should there be questions or protest, the Board of Judges shall decide on the matter. Their decision is final.
