Goals: The summit aims to train and equip individuals with critical thinking skills in reading and understanding the networks of misinformation and disinformation and to build networks of people who are equipped with the knowledge necessary to combat this issue in the information age.



Outcomes:

By the end of the summit, the participants will be able to:

1. Gain knowledge about misinformation and disinformation in the country, and how social media algorithms and echo chambers work in relation to this issue
2. Develop critical thinking skills and employ strategies that are useful in differentiating truthful/factual information from hoaxes and lies
3. Understand the roles of journalists in disseminating information that is evidence-based and relevant to the public
4. Identify how extremist ideologies are being skillfully instilled in the minds of the public; and how to be critical of the ideologies and concepts that are being taught/shared
5. Participate in community-based activities that aim to promote media and information literacy
