IDENTIFICATION OF 100 KINDERGARTEN TEACHERS FOR CHILD BLINDNESS PROGRAM TRAINING ON PRIMARY EYE CARE

- In reference to OUA Memo 00-0522-0058, titled, "Implementation of the Child Blindness Program for Kindergarten Learners", the Child Blindness Program aims to screen all kindergarten learners in public schools from ages 5 to 6 to detect early childhood vision problems. This program is in partnership with the Department of Health and the Fred Hollows Foundation.
- 2. In relation to this, primary eye care training will be provided to 100 kindergarten teachers and 25 health personnel of this Division.
- 3. Further, all Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS) are hereby directed to identify three (3) Kindergarten teachers, except for Bacong and Valencia. The latter, however, must identify two (2) to participate in the orientation of the primary eye care.
- 4. The following criteria must be considered in identifying the participants for the aforementioned training:
 - a. Kindergarten teachers assigned in schools near the highway;
 - b. willing to be trained for primary eye care screening; and
 - able to re-echo the primary eye care training to their respective districts or schools.
