In line with the Department's continued effort to lessen the teachers' non-teaching workload by removing administrative tasks from their stead, we were able to identify that our teachers are being tasked to monitor and generate reports for the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps. in their respective schools.

In this regard, we would like to inform you that we shall no longer allow our teachers to facilitate the monitoring of 4Ps in their respective institutions of learning. This is in line with the Department of Education's thrust that teachers shall focus on teaching.

Further, please be guided that Republic Act No. 11310 otherwise known as "An Act Institutionalizing the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program" and its Implementing Rules and Regulations does not mandate our department's personnel from monitoring and accomplishing reports relative to the program.

As such, we intend to advise at the soonest possible time our teachers to turn over these tasks to your personnel.
