TRAINING OF TRAINERS (Tot) FOR SELECTED ELEMENTARY MATHEMATICS FACILITATORS ON STRATEGIES AND TECHNIQUES IN TEACHING BASIC NUMERACY SKILLS

- 1. This Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct a Training of Trainers for Selected Elementary Mathematics Facilitators on Strategies and Techniques in Teaching Basic Numeracy Skills on March 22, 23 and 24, 2022 at Southview Hotel, Banilad, Dumaguete City.
- 2. This activity aims to:
 - a. develop understanding on strategies and techniques used in teaching basic numeracy skills;
 - b. capacitate participants to become facilitators during the conduct of the roll-out in their respective district;
 - c. make implementation plan for the district roll-out.
- 3. Participants of this training are the 2 teachers from each district, selected by the Public Schools District Supervisor preferably from Grade 1, 2 or 3. Please refer to the attachment for the list and the dates to report to the venue. They are required to bring laptop and extension wire. Further, they are reminded of the mandatory compliance to all health and safety protocols like the physical distancing, wearing of facemask and frequent hand washing.
- 4. Public Schools District Supervisors/DICs are required to make and issue Travel Order to their participants to the said training.
- 5. Meals and snacks (3 meals and 2 snacks) shall be charged against HRTD funds, while travel/incidental expenses incurred are chargeable against school MOOE/SEF/other available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
