 These can be achieved through the series of Massive Open Online Courses (MOOC)
 on WinS.
- 2. In view of these, this office disseminates Regional Memorandum No. 0233 s. 2022 titled "2022 Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) on Wash in Schools (WinS) for Accelerating WinS and Leading WinS"
- 3. The two-paced WinS courses will be managed by the Regional Course Management Team (RCMT) under the supervision of BLSS-SHD and GIZ personnel, it will be given to Division level personnel for the Accelerating WinS from March 28, 2022 to May 21, 2022 and School Level participants for the Leading WinS starting on March 28, 2022 until June 4, 2022.
- 4. There are 55 schools for Elementary and 15 Secondary Schools. Each school should have 2 participants. (School Head and School WinS focal person)

2022 MASSIVE OPEN ONLINE COURSE (MOOC) ON WASH IN SCHOOLS (WinS) ACCELERATING WINS and LEADING WINS

- 1. In this current pandemic situation, improvement of WASH at the school level has become the requirement to meet the minimum health standards and ensure that proper hygiene will be practiced by learners, parents and Department of Education (DepED) personnel despite of the no face to face scheme in our school and in preparation for the opening of schools.
- 2. In view thereof, as part of the DepED's response to the pandemic, the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) is implementing series of Massive Open Online Courses (MOOC) on WinS as a digital training solution to have a uniform delivery of the program's context to target audiences. Two self-paced courses will run on this MOOC, the Accelerating WinS Course and Leading WinS Course.
