

e. Able and willing to utilize course learning in their workplace environment and share them with others upon completion of the program.	
f. Must hold a permanent appointment	
g. Must have no pending administrative and/or criminal case	
h. Must have a college degree and/or sufficient demonstrated ability and experience related/ relevant to the course	
i. Must have a good command of the English language (spoken and written)	
j. Must have professional development needs aligned with DepEd's KRAs	
k. Must have outstanding accomplishments related/loading to the program applying for	
l. Must have no pending nomination for scholarship in another program/course or have already rendered the required service obligation for a scholarship previously enjoyed	
m. Physically and mentally fit
