

The SEAMEO Regional Centre for Vocational and Technical Education and Training (SEAMEO VOCTECH) announces its scholarship offering for the Virtual Regional Training Program on "Establishing, Maintaining, and Enhancing Institutional Partnership." The details of the course are as follows:

Course Title	Establishing, Maintaining, and Enhancing Institutional Partnership
Course Schedule	Dates May 16, 17, 18, 19, and 21, 2022
Delivery Mode	Online
Target Participants	The participants of the training program are heads of schools, heads of divisions/departments, and personnel in charge of industrial relations, industrial attachments or private sector engagements. Preferably, participants should have basic knowledge and understanding on basic quantitative research and computer applications, e.g. MSWord, Excel, and PowerPoint.
Course Requirements	1. The participants are required to submit a country paper. (For more information, please refer to Appendix 3: Guidelines for Preparing a Country Paper.) 2. During the workshop, participants are required to share about the partner organizations they are currently engaged with and provide

an evaluation of their partnerships' progress, success, sustainability, and challenges.

3. Participants are also encouraged to have with them their institution's strategic development plans which will be used as a source of information for the training sessions.

For selection purposes, NEAP encourage each Regional Office to nominate at least one (1) school leader/department head/head teacher with VOCTECH-related experience/s. with the following qualifications and documentary requirements:

Qualifications

- a. Filipino citizen
- b. Must be 50 years old below.
- c. At least five (5) years of service in the government (DepEd) at the time of nomination
- d. Must be computer literate and have access to a stable Internet connection to enable them to participate in online interactions.
- e. Able and willing to utilize course learning in their workplace environment and share them with others upon completion of the program.
- f. Must hold a permanent appointment
- g. Must have no pending administrative and/or criminal case
- h. Must have a college degree and/or sufficient demonstrated ability and experience related/relevant to the course
- i. Must have a good command of the English language (spoken and written)
- j. Must have professional development needs aligned with DepEd's KRAs
- k. Must have outstanding accomplishments related/leading to the program applying for
- l. Must have no pending nomination for scholarship in another program/course or have already rendered the required service obligation for a scholarship previously enjoyed
- m. Physically and mentally fit

Documentary Requirements

1. Updated Personal Data Sheet
2. Screening Form (via Google Form)
3. Rated IPCRF for the past two years
4. Endorsements from heads of the office:
 - a. Endorsement from the Schools Division Office through the Office of the SDS
 - b. Nomination Letter from the Regional/Bureau Director or his/her duly authorized representative (thru the Regional HRDD Chiefs)
5. Country paper required by SEAMEO
