

In 2016, the Department of Education issued the **Basic Education Research Agenda (BERA)** through the **DO 39, s. 2016** which aims to guide DepEd and its stakeholders in the conduct of education research and in the utilization of research results to inform the Department's planning, policy, and program development. To evaluate the implementation of the BERA (DO 39, s. 2016), the Department, through the Policy Research and Development Division-Planning Service (PRDD-PS), will conduct an **online survey**. The survey specifically aims to:

- a. understand the perception of researchers on BERA;
- b. assess the usefulness of BERA to researchers; and
- c. identify priority research topics that will guide the formulation of BERA 2022-2028.

Any DepEd personnel and external partner of DepEd who conducted research from 2016 onwards, regardless of fund source, may participate in the survey.


The PS-PRD may close the survey earlier than the deadline when the target quota per region is achieved.
