- The Philippine Elementary School Principals Association (PESPA) will hold the 39th Principals Training and Development Program Cum National Board Conference (PTDP-NBC) with the theme School Heads Braving the Challenges of Transforming the Values of the School Children in the DepEd New Normal Education-Alpha-Generation, from June 28 to 30, 2022 at the Iloilo Convention Center, Megaworld Blvd., Mandurriao, Iloilo City.
- 2. The conference aims to
 - a. enable the school heads to identify children's optimal levels of frustration and support them through their struggles,
