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## 2022 BRIGADA ESKWELA KICK-OFF AND BRIGADA ESKWELA-BRIGADA PAGBASA CONVERGENCE

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendents Chief, CID and SGOD Senior Education Program Specialists/ Education Program Specialists II Public Schools District Supervisors/Districts-In-Charge/Care Takers All Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd) shall be conducting the annual implementation of the Brigada Eskwela (BE) the annual implementation of the Brigada Eskwela (BE) on August 1-26, 2022 with the theme "Brigada Eskwela: Tugon sa Hamon ng Ligtas na Balik-Aral".
- 2. To mark the BE implementation, the National Brigada Eskwela Kick-Off Program shall be held on August 1, 2022 in Baguio City.
- 3. In consonance, the Division Brigada Eskwela Kick-off Program and the Brigada Eskwela-Brigada Pagbasa Convergence shall be held on August 9, 2022 at 7:00 AM at San Jose Central School, San Jose, Negros Oriental.
- 4. In line with the conduct of the Brigada Eskwela, School Heads are hereby requested to post Brigada Eskwela signages in their school premises and to conduct advocacy campaigns before August 1, 2022. This is to encourage maximum participation of community volunteers.
- 5. This year's BE shall focus on the following:
  - a. implementation of the year-round schools' maintenance and repair activities, which includes the provision of the immediate needs during disaster or calamities, and the addressing of resource gaps during the reopening of the face-to-face classes;
  - b. strengthened partnership engagements with partners and stakeholders that complement DepEd's efforts to ensure quality basic education;
  - c. achievement of significant goals which shall contribute in increasing students' participation rate, reducing drop-outs and helping improve learning for both learners and community; and
  - d. creation of a network of community-based organization to get total community commitment for collaborative programs and projects



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including the Brigada Pagbasa and other support and volunteer/community-based projects.

- 6. Expected participants in the 2022 Division Brigada Eskwela Kick-Off and Brigada Eskwela-Brigada Pagbasa Convergence are the following:
  - a. Schools Division Superintendent;
  - b. Assistant Schools Division Superintendents;
  - c. Division Chiefs;
  - d. CID Education Program Supervisors, Coordinators, and Education Program Specialists II;
  - e. SGOD Senior Education Program Specialists, Education Program Specialists II and Project Development Officers;
  - f. Public Schools District Supervisors, Districts-In-Charge, and District Care Takers:
  - g. Provincial Government Officials;
  - h. Congress Representatives;
  - i. Municipal Officials of the Host District;
  - j. Division Federated PTA Officers and San Jose District School PTA Presidents:
  - k. Government Agencies' Representatives;
  - Private Industries' Representatives;
  - m. School Heads and School ASP Coordinators of the Host District; and
  - n. Members of the Technical Working Group.
- 7. Motorcade shall be conducted at 6:30 AM which will commence from Crisostomo O. Retes National High School and end at the San Jose Central Participants in the motorcade are the San Jose representatives/personnel, School PTA Officers, San Jose District School Heads, School ASP Coordinators, and identified San Jose District Teachers. The District Supervisor of San Jose District is hereby requested to facilitate the necessary requirements and creation of committee for the conduct of the district motorcade.
- 8. Participants are encouraged to wear any Brigada Eskwela or DepEd shirt and to bring extra working clothes, cleaning, painting, or gardening materials.
- 9. Travelling and other expenses incurred by participants in the activity shall be charged against their MOOE/local funds while morning snacks and lunch shall be charged against partnership funds. All are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
