- g. Must have no pending administrative and/or criminal case
- Must have a college degree and/or sufficient demonstrated ability and experience related/relevant to the course he/she is applying for
- Must have a good command of the English language (spoken and written)
- Must have professional development needs aligned with the KRAs of the organization.
- Must have outstanding accomplishments related/leading to the program applying for
- Must have no pending nomination for scholarship in another program/course or have already rendered the required service obligation for a scholarship previously enjoyed
- m. Physically and mentally fit

- Endorsement from the Schools
 Division Office through the Office of the SDS
- Nomination Letter from the Regional/Bureau Director or his/her duly authorized representative (thru the Regional HRDD Chiefs)

The Participant Nomination Form and required documents must be filled out and uploaded on or before August 10, 2022, through this Google Form https://bit.ly/VOCTECHAug2022. Please use the official DepEd email accounts and submit the documents in PDF.

Kindly take note that upon completion of the ten-day training in Singapore, all participants are then called Master Trainers. With the assistance of the local/regional government, they will be required to conduct a five-day post-training program to share their experience with their colleagues in their own country within four months after the training, which is a mandatory requirement for attending this program.
