## PRIMARY EYE CARE EDUCATION CAMPAIGN TO KINDERGARTEN PARENTS

- 1. In reference to OUA Memo 00-0522-0058, titled, "Implementation of the Child Blindness Program for Kindergarten Learners", the Child Blindness Program aims to screen all kindergarten learners in public schools from ages 5 to 6 to detect early childhood vision problems. This program is in partnership with the Department of Health and the Fred Hollows Foundation.
- 2. In line with this, all trained School Health Personnel will conduct primary eye care health teaching to select kindergarten parents. This activity aims to increase the knowledge of parents of kindergarten learners about primary eye care and the importance of early screening.
- 3. This education campaign will be scheduled on the last 2 weeks of August.
- 4. The School Health personnel will coordinate with the Public Schools District Supervisors and School Heads on the specific schedule of the campaign.
- All participants are required to follow minimum health standards and protocols set by the local Inter-Agency Task Force by using face masks and practice physical distancing during the conduct of this activity.
