



in Performing Arts

The guidelines for submission to the Performing Arts Workshop are as follows:

- 1) Submissions must be in any of the genres and specifications:
 - theater arts (performance art): video demonstration of the scene performance with clear audio recording in .mp4 video file format
 - theater Arts (immersive or interactive theater): video or audio demonstration of the immersive theater piece with the use of one or more theatrical elements such as, and not limited to, sound design, video design, lighting design, website performance design
 - · dance and movement art: performance of an originally choreographed dance
 - music and sonic art: performance of original composition (single or extended play (EP))
- 2) Works must be original and currently owned by the artist. Commissioned or sold works are not accepted.
- 3) Submissions must have the following filename format: **Genre_Title_Artist's Last Name** in high resolution .mp3 or .mp4
- 4) Submissions must be received on or before **February 18, 2022.**
- 5) Students may submit multiple entries in different genres. However, a student will **only** participate in **one** workshop under **one** genre and entry.



in Creative Writing

The guidelines for submission to the Creative Writing Workshop are as follows:

- 1) Submissions must be in any of the genres, in English or Filipino:
 - fiction: a short story on any theme with three to six pages
 - flash fiction: a 500-word flash fiction story on any theme
 - · poetry: at least three poems on the same theme
 - · creative nonfiction: a personal essay on any theme with three to six pages
 - drama: a one-act play on any theme with seven to ten pages
 - film: a short film script on any theme with seven to ten pages
- 2) The file must be formatted as follows: on an $8.5'' \times 11$ Word document, 12, Arial, double-spaced, one-inch margin on all sides.
- 3) Submissions must be original and previously unpublished.
- 4) Submissions must have the following filename format: Genre_Title_Writer's Last Name in .doc or .docs extension. For poetry submissions, provide an overarching title to the set of poems.
- 5) Submissions must be received on or before **February 18, 2022.**
- 6) Students may submit multiple entries in different genres. However, a student will **only** participate in **one** workshop under **one** genre and entry.
