UTILIZATION OF REGIONAL INITIATED PACKAGE OF ASSESSMENT AND INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES IN SCIENCE (PAIRS)

To

- Assistant Schools Division Superintendents Chiefs, CID and SGOD Public Schools District Supervisors/District In-Charge Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned
- 1. Relative to the efforts of the Department of Education Regional Office VII to help in providing quality and accessible instructional materials to support the teaching-learning process in schools, the Office of the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), DepEd Region VII, specifically in the Science Curriculum Learning Area hereby announces the availability of Package of Assessment and Instructional Resources in Science (PAIRS).
- 2. The said package can be accessed through **google classroom** with the code: **q3i5eqj.**
- 3. All science teachers in this division are highly encouraged to access and utilize the materials which is composed of the following:
 - 3.1. **Competency-Based Test Items (CBTI)** developed by select Master Teachers and Supervisors in Science whose main aim is to provide a Test Bank of quality assured and field-tested Test items that are aligned to the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCS). The CBTI is complete from Grades 1-12 in Q1-Q4.
 - 3.2. **Short Creative Video Lessons (Siyensikula)** developed by our learners as entry to the Regional Science Fair coached by our Science Teachers focusing on the critical learning content and topics in Science whose aim is to provide an understandable explanation of the seemingly difficult topic or the least learned competencies.
 - 3.3. Self-Learning Modules in Science with Financial Literacy Integration – developed by our science teachers as entry to the search for the best SLM with integration in Financial Literacy whose aim is to train the young learners in the concept and importance of saving and managing



finances. This search was organized by DepEd BCD and co-organized by DO and Huawei Philippines last February 2022.

- 3.4. Curriculum Mapped Competencies with integration in Robotics, Digital Learning Resources, and Problem-based Learning – developed by our Master Teachers who served as curriculum mappers whose output was to integrate the emerging concepts in the Science Curriculum through the MELCS. Suggested activities, links to resources, and problem-based materials are provided in the curriculum.
- 4. All science teachers in this division are expected to adapt and gauge the effectiveness of these materials in their local setting.
- 5. For guidance and widest dissemination.
