- 1. This is to announce that the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Eastern Visayas Region will conduct the :
 - Event : REGIONAL SCOUT VENTURE CAMP
 - Date : December 26-30, 2022
 - Venue : Capitol Hills Scout Camp, Cebu City
 - Host : Cebu Council
- The Scout Venture Camp aims to provide opportunities for Senior Scouts to practice and enhance their physical, social, mental, emotional and spiritual potentials. Discover and act upon their strength through challenging, adventurous and experimental learning activities.

3. Qualifications for participation:

- A. Participating Senior Scouts are expected to have leadership potentials, sufficient camping experience, physically fit to undergo strenuous activities with parent's approval and must be:
 - Currently registered as a Senior Scout
 - 13 years old but not over 17 years old
 - Holder of at least Pathfinder Rank
 - · Equipped with camping gears, and
 - Fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
- B. Adult Leaders:
 - Currently registered
 - · Trained as an Outfit Advisor and have served as OA or AOA for at least 2 years
 - Physically fit as certified by a physician
 - · Equipped with camping gears, and
 - Fully vaccinated against COVID 19
- Registration Fee of Seven Hundred Pesos (Php700.00) shall be charged each participant to defray expenses for the program materials, certificates, souvenir items, administrative costs and other operating expenses.

Registration Fees for the Scout Venture Camp must be remitted directly to the host council, with the following details:

5. The standard camping equipment as prescribed in activities of this nature should be brought by every contingent. Scouts must cook their own meals. All contingents are expected to have adequate food supply to last for the duration of the Scout Venture Camp.

Good day!

The Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Eastern Visayas Region will conduct the Regional Scout Venture Camp on December 26 - 30, 2022 at the Capitol Hills Scout Camp, Cebu City with the theme : "Sustaining Growth".

The Scout Venture Camp aims to provide opportunities for Senior Scouts to practice and enhance their physical, social, mental emotional and spiritual potentials. Discover and act upon their strengths through challenging, adventurous and experimental learning activities.

A. Qualifications for Participation:

1. Participating Senior Scouts are expected to have leadership potentials, sufficient camping experience, physically fit to undergo strenuous with parent's approval and must be;

- currently registered as a Senior Scout

- 13 years old but not over 19 years old
- holder of a least Explorer Rank
- equipped with camping gears
- fully Vaccinated from the COVID-19

B. Adult Leader must have the maturity and clarity about his role must be;

- currently registered

- trained as an Outfit Advisor and have served as Outfit Advisor for at least 2 years
- must be of good moral character
- physically fit as certified by a physician
- equipped with camping gears
- fully vaccinated against COVId-19

C. As per computation of the Local Council each participant shall be charged FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P 5,500.00) to defray foods,

transportation fees, souvenir items chargeable to MOOE, SEF and other Local Funds available subject to government auditing and accounting rules and regulations. This amount shall be remitted to the BSP, Negros Oriental - Siquijor Council on or before December 19, 2022 as agreed during the Contingent Meeting last December 8, 2022.

D. **Participation Ratio**. One (1) Adult Leader for every eight (8) scouts must to exercise efficient outfit leadership management.

E. **Food Provision**. The Council will be the one to prepare food and other basic requirements that will be sufficient throughout the entire duration of the Venture Camp. A Jambo Market will be set up for the availability of the food supplies.

F. **Transportation and Equipment**. The Council will be responsible for arranging the transportation to and from the campsite. Like any other camping, Scouts and Adult Leaders are required to provide their own equipment and gadgets.

G. It is expected that the Local Council shall organize their contingents and start preparation without delay. Efforts should be vigorously exerted maximum participation in this activity.

H. The Contingent will be leaving from Dumaguete City on December 26, 2022 at 9:00 o'clock in the morning.
