**UPSKILLING TEACHERS ON MULTIGRADE INSTRUCTION
IN THE LAST MILE SCHOOLS**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Attached is DM-CI-2022-00258 from Usec. Diosdado M. San Antonio, Undersecretary for Curriculum and Instruction entitled "Upskilling Teachers on Multigrade Instruction in the Last Mile Schools," on August 1-6, 2022 in Cebu City (specific venue shall be announced later).
2. Participants to the activity who shall be identified by the division multigrade focal person, are teachers who are currently teaching in last mile schools or multigrade schools, in remote, disadvantaged, and marginalized communities (see enclosure no. 1 for the allocated number of participants); willing to stay in a multigrade school upon completion of the training for a minimum period of **2 years**; able to share all learnings gained from training with other multigrade teachers; and medically fit to engaged in training. They are expected to be at the venue before the opening program at 8:30am on the first day of the training workshop.
3. In accordance with the provision of DO No. 19, s. 2011 and DO No.53 s. 2003, teacher-participants shall be entitled to service credits.
4. Travel and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants relative to their participation in the activity shall be charged against 2022 Support Funds for Multigrade Schools downloaded to the region, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The Bureau of Learning Delivery through the Teaching and Learning Division will conduct a training-workshop to upskill teachers and expand their capabilities in handling Multigrade classes in the last mile schools. This training supports the Basic Education Development Plan 2030 (BEDP 2030) in addressing the immediate impact of the pandemic on learning, participation, and education delivery in the Multigrade context. The training aims to equip teachers with the knowledge and skills essential to multigrade instruction specifically on the development and utilization of various Multigrade teaching and learning resources, implementation of blended learning modalities, teaching reading in the early grades, adoption of appropriate teaching strategies and techniques, classroom management, assessment, and monitoring and evaluation.

The training-workshop will be conducted by cluster of regions on the following specified dates:

- 1) currently teaching in the last mile schools and/or Multigrade schools in remote, disadvantaged, and marginalized communities;
- 2) willing to stay in the Multigrade school upon completion of the training for a minimum period of 2 years;
- 3) able to share all learnings gained from the training with other Multigrade teachers; and
- 4) medically fit to engage in the training.

Priority is given to the participants from schools divisions with a considerable number of last mile Multigrade schools and/or MG classes. Below is the breakdown of participants by region:
