


The National Music Competitions for Young Artists (NAMCYA) Foundation Inc., in cooperation with the Department of Education (DepEd), National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP), and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), announces the holding of the **2022 National Music Competitions for Young Artists (NAMCYA)**. Its culmination shall be during the National Music Week with the theme, "**Maglayog (Lumipad)**" from **November 16 to 21, 2022** at the **CCP Complex, Roxas Boulevard, Pasay City**.

The conduct of this activity is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 25, s. 1998, which declares the last week of November of each year as the National Music Week wherein NAMCYA Competitions are the main focus of the celebration.

In 2001, President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo also signed Presidential Proclamation No. 80, s. 2001, which affirms NAMCYA's mission for the nation's Young Artists. This proclamation further designates the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) as the primary supporting agency of this endeavor.

This year, the Senate Committee on Youth Chairman, Hon. Senator Juan Edgardo "Sonny" Angara welcomed the enactment of three (3) laws that will foster the development of young Filipinos as future leaders and productive members of the society. One of these three laws is the Republic Act (R.A.) No. 11915, which designates the National Music Competitions for Young Artists (NAMCYA) as the Philippine National Youth Development Program for Music.

The Regional Directors (RDs), assisted by their Regional and Schools Division Coordinators are designated as heads of the NAMCYA Regional Committees to oversee the identification, selection and training of participants in their respective areas. The NAMCYA Secretariat shall undertake national coordination.

The concerned Regional Coordinators for Culture and the Arts in the Regional Center Competitions are requested to identify and select **at least 50 learners** from the Special Program in the Arts Schools or nearby public secondary schools offering Music Education Program to participate in the various workshops in the morning and to attend the competition in the afternoon of the same day. The events must be conducted on a Saturday in compliance with DepEd Order (DO) No. 034, s. 2022 to avoid disruption of classes. Teachers in Music, MAPEH Supervisors, Performing Arts and Social Sciences subjects are expected to attend the Regional and National Final Competitions and the Workshops on Traditional Philippine Music.

The amount of Thirty Thousand Pesos (P30,000.00) to cover for meals (am snacks, lunch, and pm snacks) and Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) for board and lodging shall be downloaded by the External Partnerships Service-Special Events Unit (EPS-SEU) to the following host Regional Offices (ROs)/Schools Division Offices (SDOs):

Travel expenses and per diem of the EPS-SEU Technical Working Group (TWG)/secretariat members during the Regional and National Competitions shall be charged against AC-22-EPS-SEU-BPLP-016, while expenses to be incurred by the NAMCYA regional coordinators, supervisors, teachers and participants during the Semi-Final and Final Competitions shall be charged to local funds, regional/division MOOE, PTA/PTCA funds, local school board funds and other sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The following activities shall be part of said program:

- a. Seminar-Workshop
- b. Semi-final round competitions; and
- c. National Final Competitions at CCP Complex, Pasay City.


