UPSKILLING OF REGIONAL AND DIVISION READING S JPERVISORS/COORDINATORS ON THE EARLY LANGUAGE LITERACY AND NUMERACY (ELLN) WITH FOCUS ON THE SCIENCE OF READING

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. The Bureau of Learning Delivery-Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD) will conduct the Upskilling of Regional and Division Reading Supervisors/Coordinators on the Early Language Literacy and Numeracy (ELLN) with Focus on the Science of Reading (Visayas Cluster Region VI, VII, VIII) on December 1-7, 2022 at Hotel Fortuna, Borromeo St., Cebu City. - 2. The activity aims to:
 - a. upskill the region/division ELLN Coordinators' capacity to use a knowledge-based pedagogy to become effective reading planners;
 - b. enhance participants' capacity to provide technical assistance to the K TO 3 teachers; and
 - c. promote and sustain a culture of reading in schools, and even in the communities.
